SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING 2016-2017

From September 2013 the government have been allocating funding directly to primary schools to support the provision of quality PE and sport. Each school will receive £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year for the next two years. This funding can only be spent on extending the provision of PE and sport in schools.

At Parbold Douglas Academy we consider Physical Education to be of the utmost importance. In recent years, we have seen the benefits gained from participation in high quality sport and we endeavour to provide our children with as many sporting opportunities as possible. We are constantly raising standards and encouraging children to achieve their best in a variety of ways; especially with sport. By no means are we a 'win at all cost' school but we highly value the skills and attitudes that can be developed in a competitive environment. We wholeheartedly believe that P.E contributes significantly to academic and social performance in and out of the school environment.

Skills that are enhanced through Physical Education include: children learning to co-operate, being able to accept advice, considering the perspective of others and perseverance. In lessons and through extra-curricular activities our children learn to listen and process instructions whilst taking ownership of their own learning and the learning of their peers. We aim to teach them to take risks in working through challenges where they can discover a favoured outcome. All of this is hugely relevant and supports the delivery of our curriculum throughout the school.
